## •|| WORKSHOPS AND SEMINARS ||•

### 14 November 2018: Regional Summit of School Principals ♦♦

VIS hosted Regional Summit of School Principal, along with ITRC. The theme of the summit was “Students at Risk-Identification, Prevention and Intervention”. The principals of several schools, from in and around Jodhpur, participated. The chief speaker at the conference was Dr. V S Ravindran, founder ITRC and a renowned psychologist. The Principal of Vidhyashram, welcomed the guest and participated actively in all the three sessions of the speakers. Prof Keshav and Dr. Naresh from AIIMS Jodhpur, stressed on the need of identifying and counseling students, who are at constant risk of stress, depression and peer pressure.



### 24 November 2018: Hindi workshop ♦♦

A Hindi subject workshop was conducted Madhuban Publication at Chandra Imperial Hotel. Mrs. Seema Tak and Mrs. Sarita Makwana of VIS attended the workshop. Recourse person was Dr. Pradeep Jain, who explained resolving general problems in teaching Hindi subject, How to prepare precise and crisp lesson plan, how to improve hindi handwriting and reading was the main agenda of the workshop. Suggestion was given to club the Hindi activities for kids to ITC. It was emphasized to discuss the chapter according to the level of the students of the class.

### 25 November 2018: Re-inventing libraries as spaces for learning and thinking ♦♦

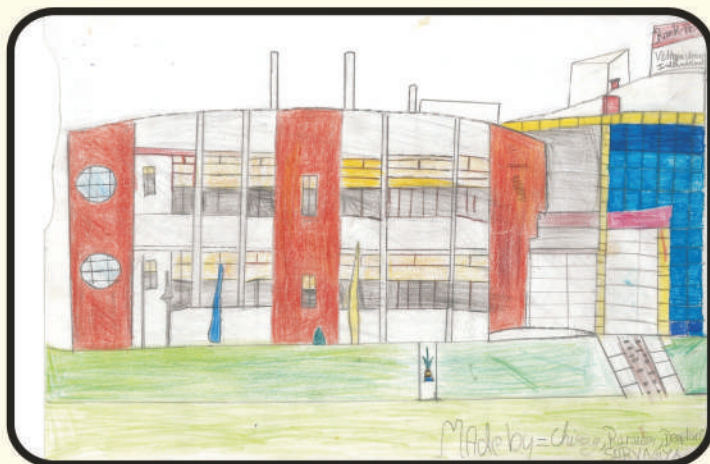

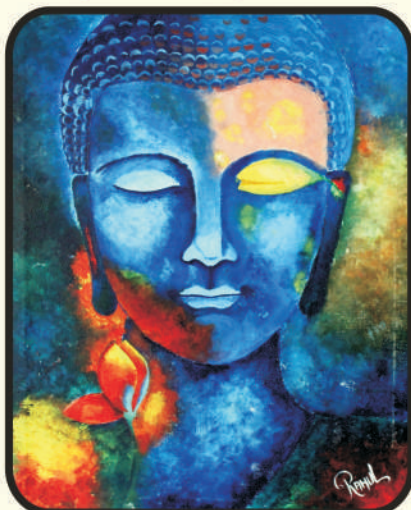

## • || INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL AWARD (ISA) ACTIVITIES || •

### 16 November 2018: Inspiring Cartoons ♦♦♦

Students of class XI participated in an Inter House Quiz Competition on various International Days celebrated in the school in the span of August 2018 to January 2019.

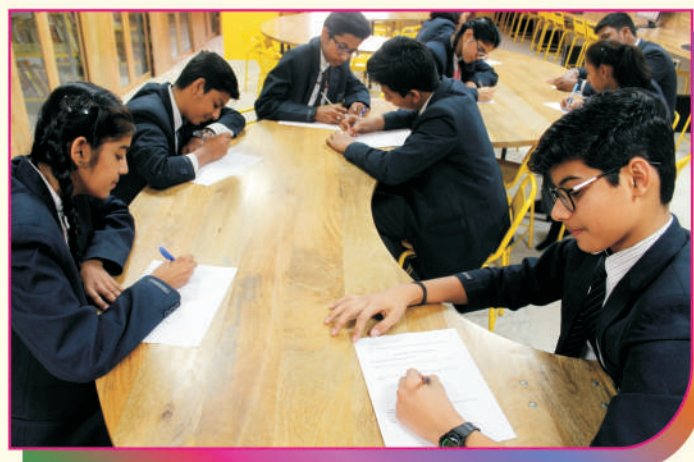
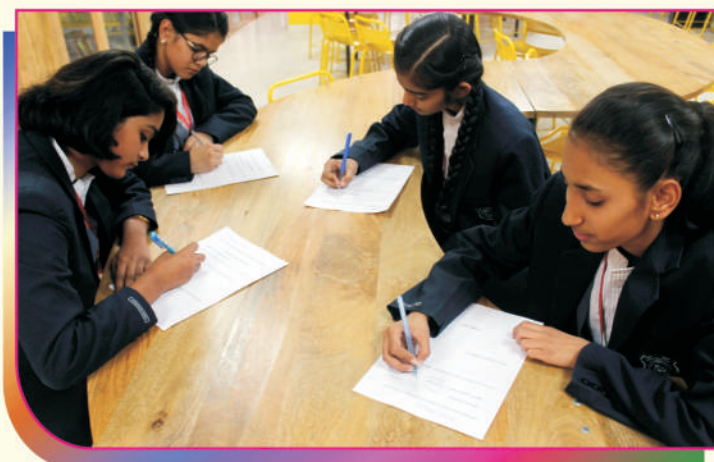
The students participated enthusiastically in the three round quiz competition which consisted of multiple choice questions, buzzer round and audio visual round.
