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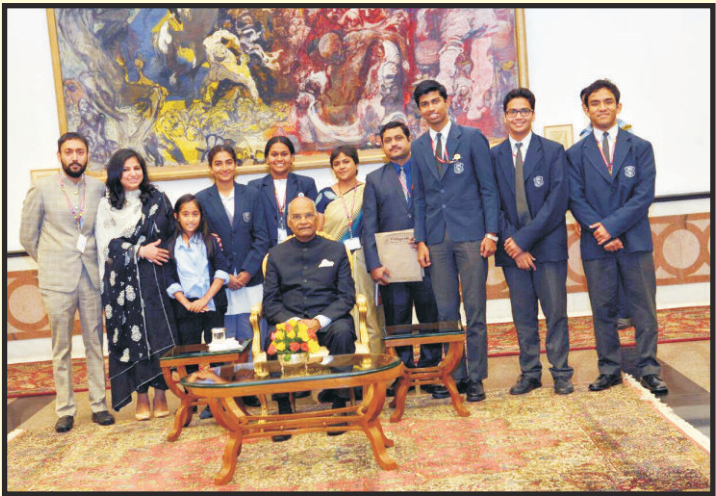

SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

9th December 2017: Jaipur World Schools Debating Championship

VIS participated in Jaipur World Schools Debating Championship, an initiative taken by A Responsible Citizen's Foundation (ARC) in collaboration with Indian Schools Debating Society (ISDS), the National Health Mission, and the Gandhi Foundation. It was conducted as a part of ISDS's regional selection process for the Indian national team to WSDC 2018.



Around 20 schools from Jaipur, Jodhpur and Surat participated in the competition that was held at Jayshree Periwal High School, Jaipur.

The school team emerged as winner after competing in various rounds with diverse set of motions, exhibiting immense confidence and speaking skills to influence the judges and audience.

After beating several teams in various rounds, the school reached the finals to debate with Jayshree Periwal High School, in a riveting and hotly contested finals on "Whether There Should be Any Limits on Free Speech". Our team came out with flying colours and won the trophy.

The team members, Ayushi Gupta, Shreya Singh and Shubhangi Rathore, made it to the intermediate rounds of the WSDC selection process. The selected students will participate for National Selections to be held in Chennai in January 2018.

The team presented the content in a logical and well-planned manner and stood apart from the rest. The experience was enriching for the team as they were exposed to a completely new debating format. Important lessons in public speaking, team efforts, strategic planning and withstanding pressure, were learnt.

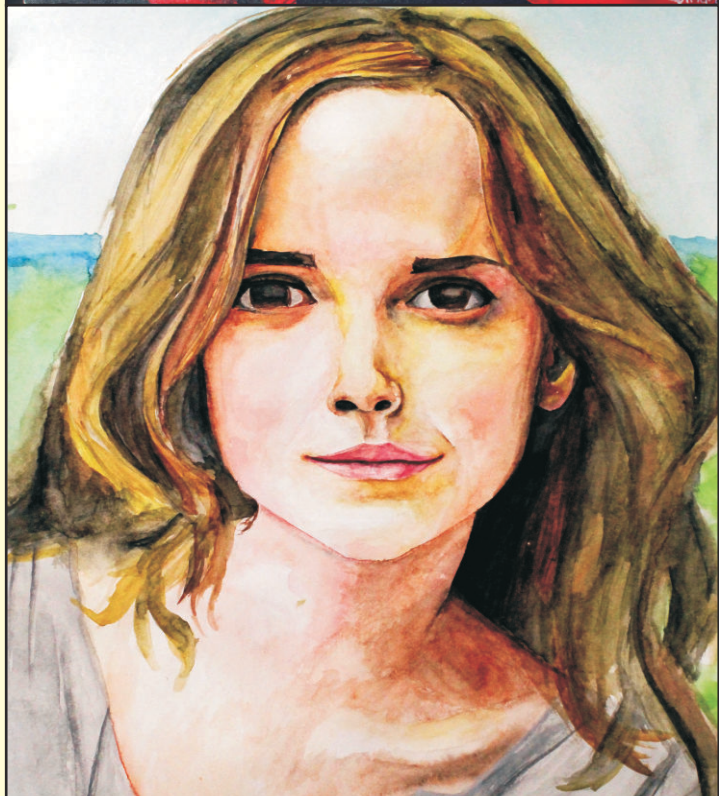
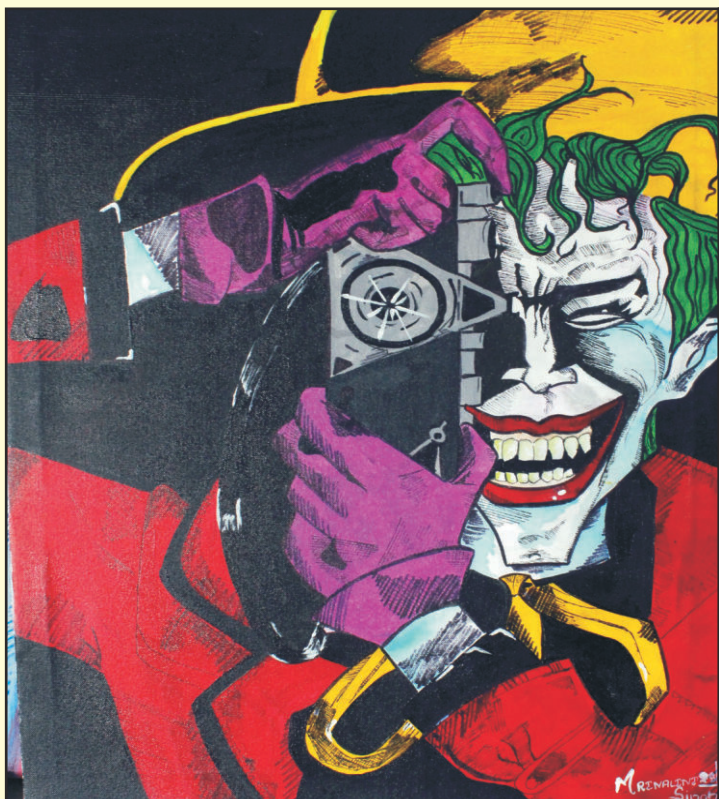
13th September 2017: Green – The colour of Prosperity and Harmony
