




Awards and Achievements

15th August 2020: 74thIndependence Day Celebration




Class 7 took pleasure in learning about Festivals of the World. They thoroughly enjoyed learning about various festivals.





















Diwali Message from Principal






NO MASK, NO ENTRY OATH




