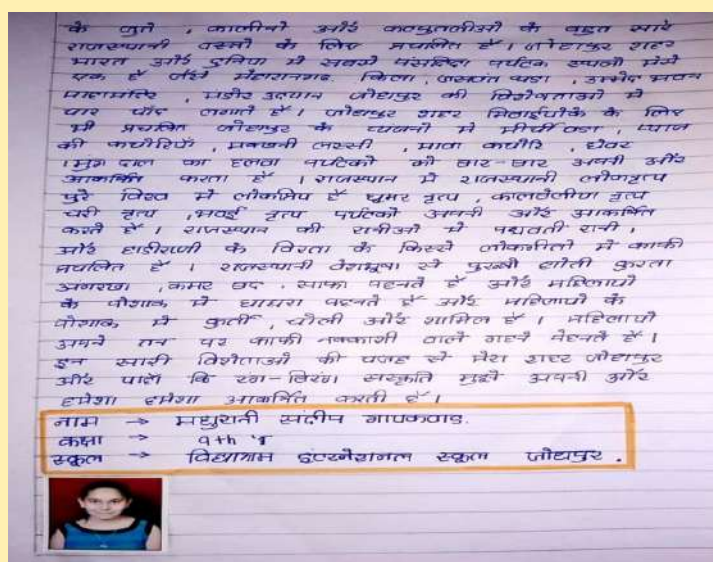
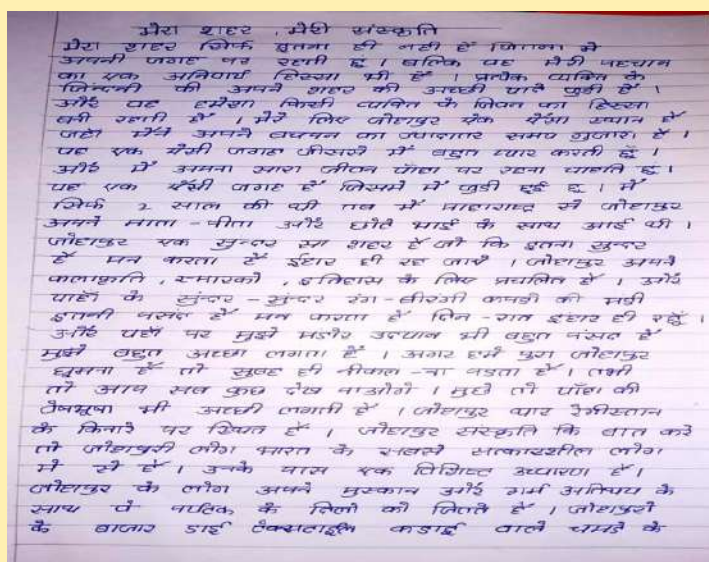

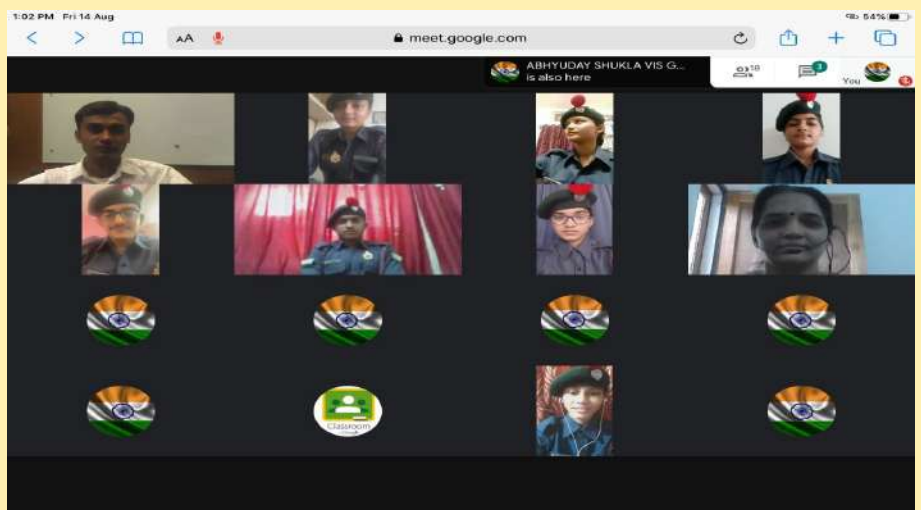
The efforts of these little ones were praiseworthy as they kept the spirit of the festival alive even in this period of pandemic.

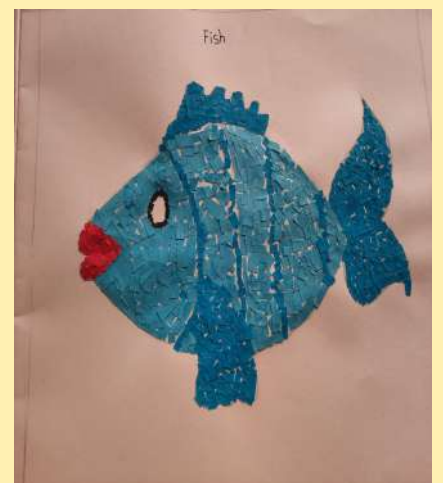
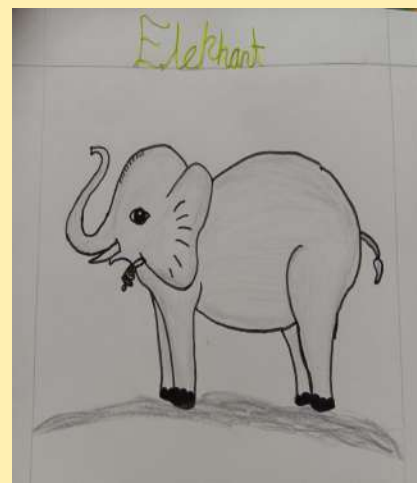
25th December 2020: Christmas Celebration.

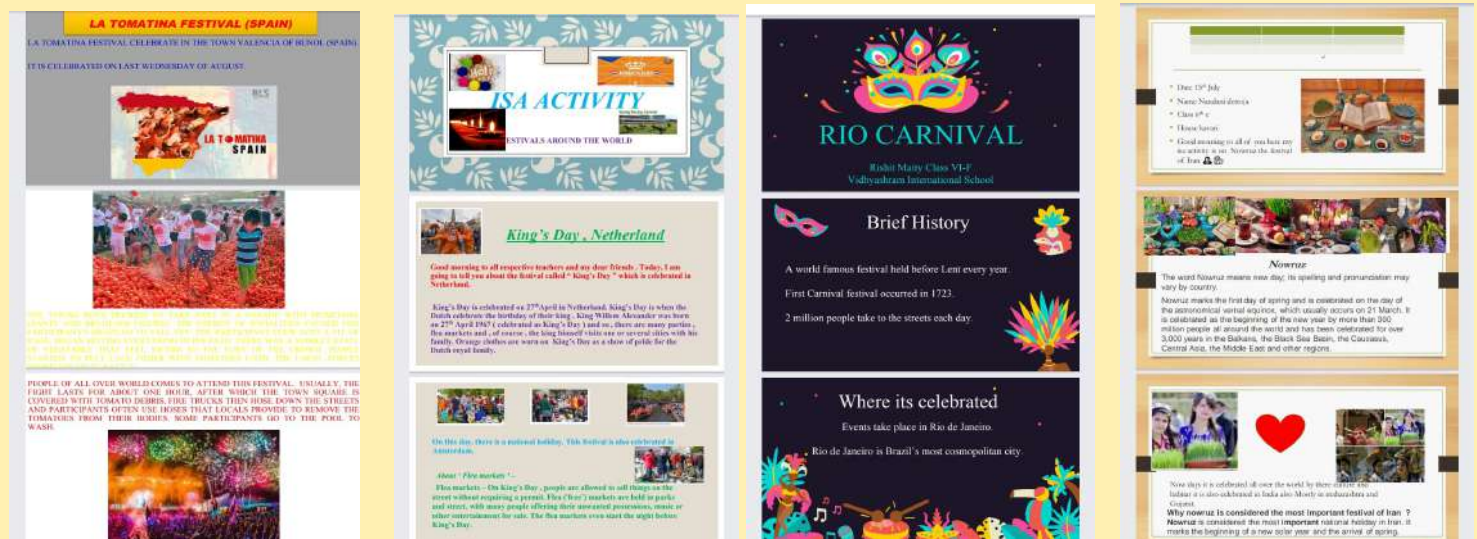
ISA ACTIVITY (MIDDLE WING)

The school has always tried for all round development of students. In this pursuit, IAS Activity was introduced for the students.

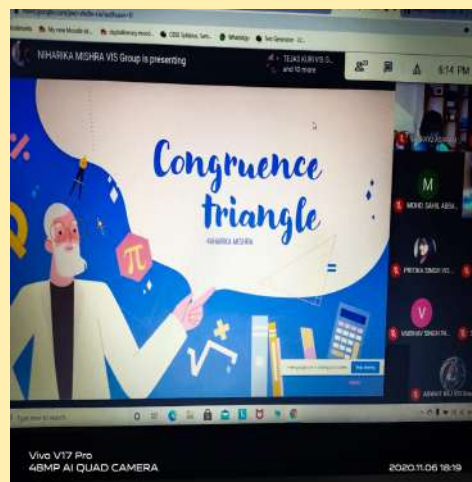
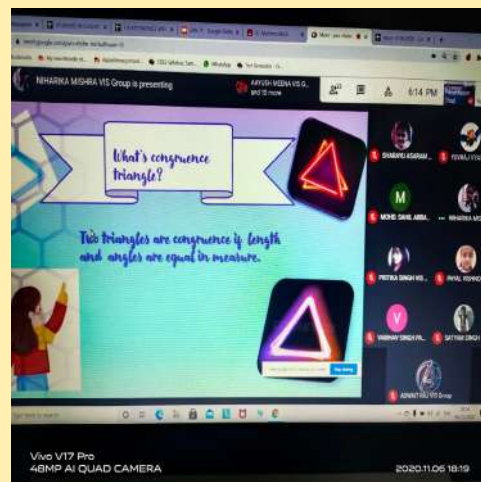
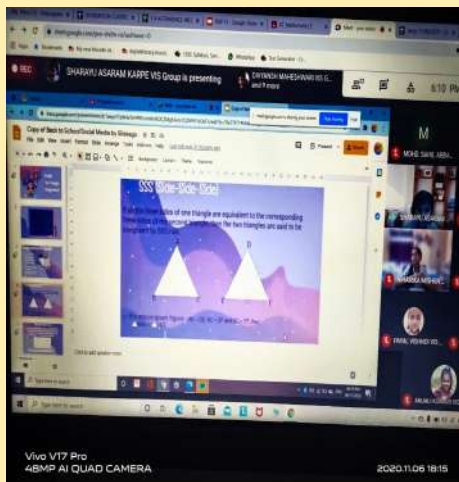
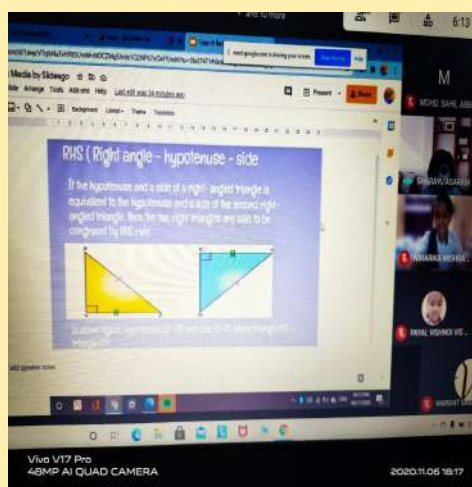
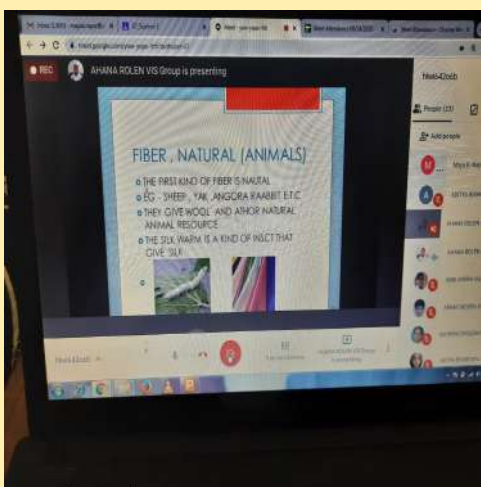
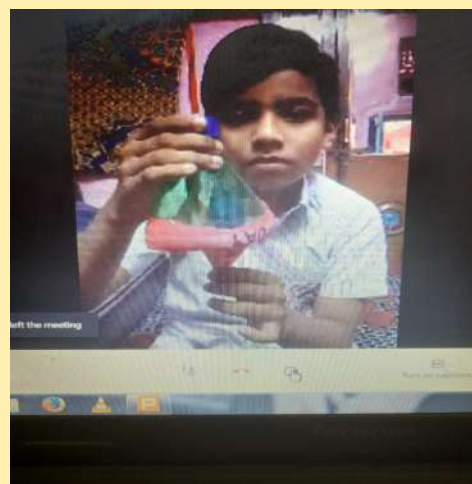
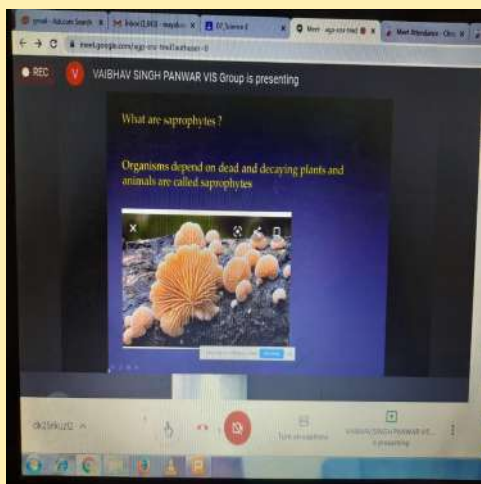

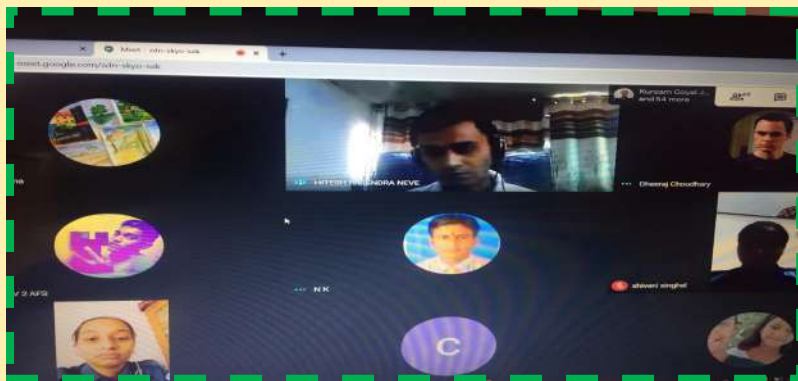
TREE PLANTATION

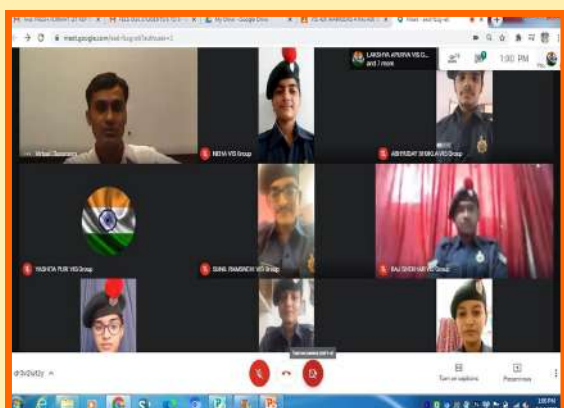

NCC ACTIVITIES

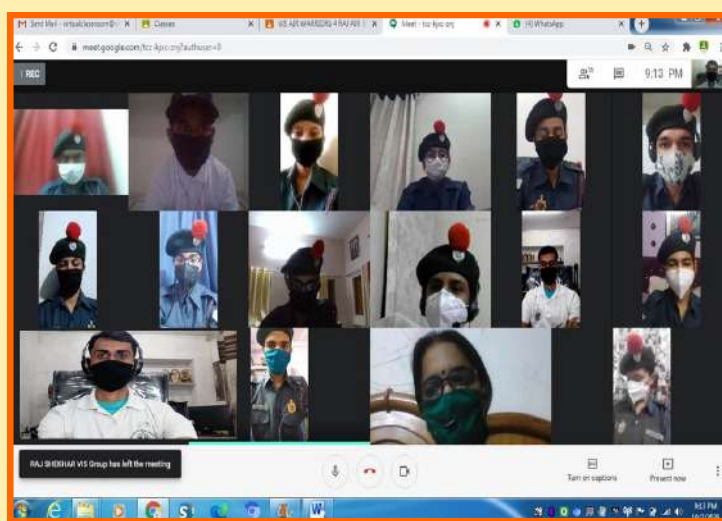
15th AUGUST (INDEPENDENCE DAY) CELEBRATION:

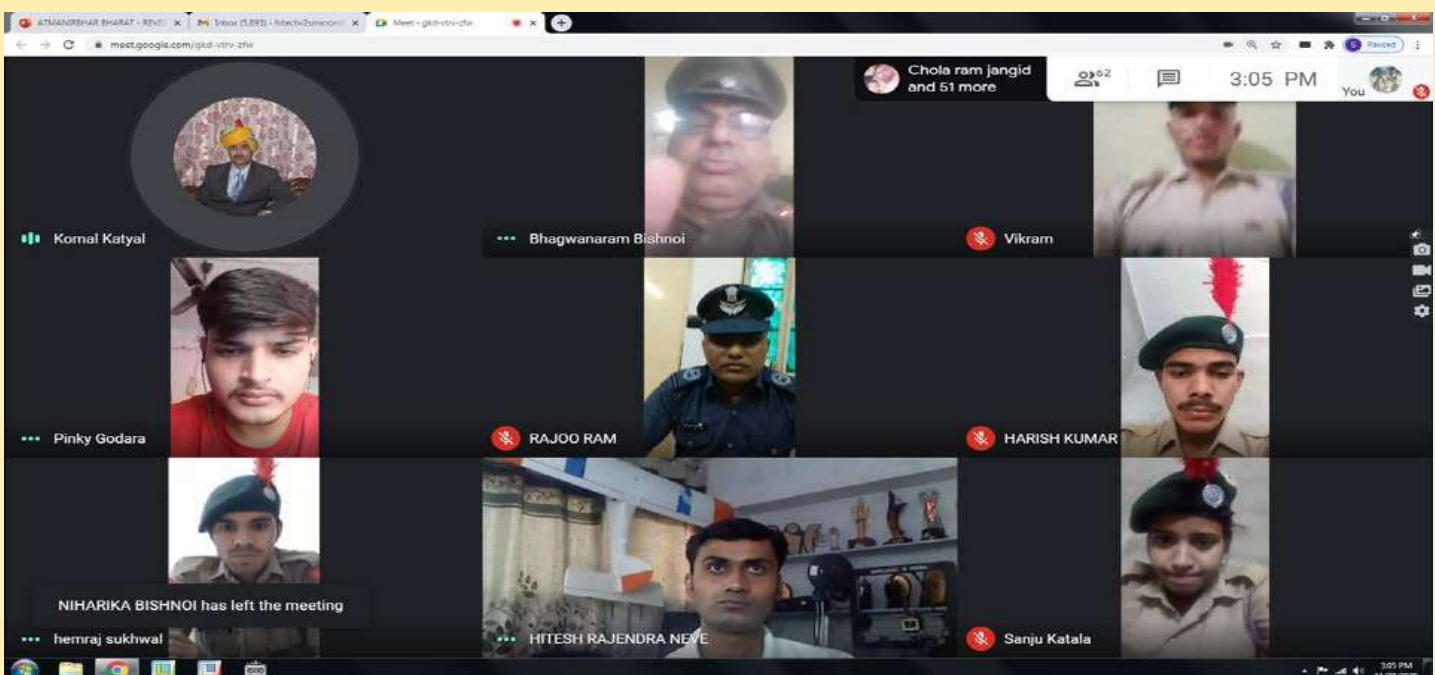
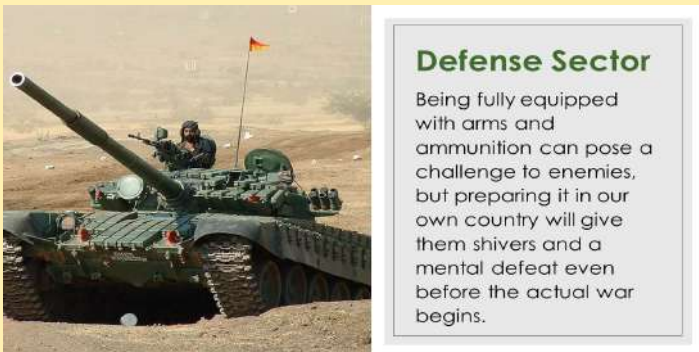
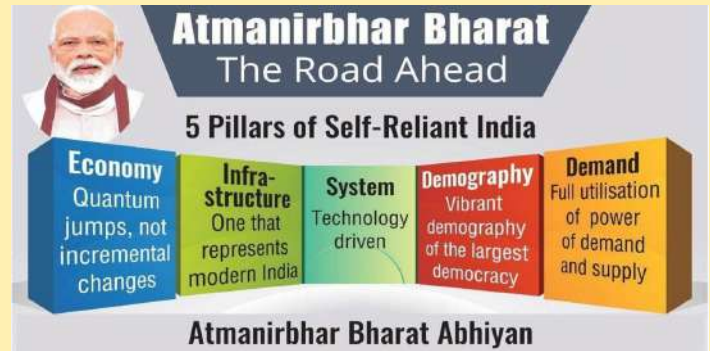
