The hard work of illustrious teachers in these pandemic times, the guidance and motivation of Principal and Vice-Principal Sir goes a long way to make the institute attain its academic norms year after year.

CBSE Class XII board result of 2021 batch once again stood up to its entrenched standards. A good number of students from different streams scored 478 marks out of 500 with final percentages of 95.6 including two commerce students; Khushi Tapariya and Tushar Karwa who scored 95.8 % standing out as school toppers. Thirty-seven young scholars scored ninety percent and above with individual subjects total rising to 99 % in Math's, History, Physical Education, Computer Science, Hindi Geography, Economics, Political Science, and Fine Arts. The school would like to congratulate these stalwarts and their proud parents who withstood the testing times continued their relentless efforts and came out as achievers.



08TH OCTBER 2021: INDIAN AIRFORCE DAY




EK BHARAT SHERATHA BHARAT- EBSB10 (Virtual-Camp)
