

This motivational session aimed to support and encourage our students in their academic journey, fostering a culture of excellence and empowerment.




17th JULY: TRAINING SESSION ON SELF-DEFENCE SKILL IN KUDO

Mrs. Parminder Kaur, Head of Primary Wing, applauded the students' efforts and encouraged them to continue striving for excellence.




21st JUNE: INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY
