The Central Bank of India team shared insights on financial literacy, banking products, and government schemes, encouraging students to develop an understanding of financial systems from a young age.



This celebration showcased the school's commitment to fostering civic awareness, patriotism, and responsible citizenship among its students.




05th DEC: SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON ROAD SEAFY




06th MARCH: TEACHERS' RECREATION DAY




07th APRIL: PARENTS' ORIENTATION (PRIMARY WING)
